2012–2013 GRADUATE FOLLOW-UP REPORT

The Graduate Follow-Up Report presents the results of a survey of recent graduates of Des Moines Area Community College (DMACC). The survey asked graduates to report their employment status, their continuing education plans and their entry-level salary. This report is used by prospective students, counselors, employers and others interested in the professional and academic pursuits of DMACC graduates. While the statistics may be a general indicator, they are not intended to provide salary forecasts or to determine which careers offer the greatest salary potential.

ALL 2013 DMACC GRADUATES WERE SURVEYED; THE RESPONSE RATE WAS 54%

Of the respondents:

90% of those looking for work found employment.

28% of paraprofessionals (Science and Humanities) are employed and 70% are continuing their education.

9% of the Arts and Sciences graduates are employed and 88% have continued their education.

52% of the graduates of Career Education programs are employed and 42% are continuing their education.

Of the employed graduates, 95% remain in Iowa.
