The student budget, or Cost of Attendance (COA), is not intended to be the actual final cost. Actual costs will vary based on enrollment, living and purchasing decisions. Scholarships, grants, and loans can be used to pay these costs.

Costs listed below assume in-state, in-person, full-time enrollment (15 credits in a single term; 30 credits for the academic year, & 10 credits in summer). Some additional costs and scenarios are included below.

Other Costs:

<u>Costs or fees of first professional license or certificate exams:</u> The approximate costs or fees associated with obtaining or taking tests for the first required professional certificate or license may be included. The license or certificate must be required for employment and the cost must be incurred during enrollment in the appropriate program. The test may be taken after graduation. The expenses will be added automatically per verification of enrollment in the appropriate educational program.

<u>Federal Loan Fees</u>: Federal loan fees are automatically added to the student budget upon acceptance of the loan. Currently 1% of the loan amount requested.

Specialized Supplies and Tools: Some programs have special tools or other supply requirements. See individual program pages for specific requirements. If necessary, costs can be adjusted.

<u>Other fees:</u> Some courses and programs have additional fees. See individual program pages for more detail on specialized costs for the program of choice.

The following changes can also be considered. All changes require notification to the financial aid office and support documentation. Not all changes will result in 100% budget match or additional financial aid funds.

- Costs of a computer or other significant supply needs related to the student's declared major/course
- Significant dependent or child care expenditures
- Significant documented transportation costs
- Medical expenses not covered by insurance
