Interested in coaching K-12 sponsored athletics in Iowa?

1. Must be 18 years or older
2. Choose your DMACC program (credit courses or continuing education)
3. Once you have successfully completed the required coursework, you will need to send the following items to the state licensure board (www.coaching.iowa.gov) for processing:
 - a. Completed online application for Coaching Authorization
 - b. Certificate of successful completion of the Concussion Video Training
 - c. Transcript(s) showing you have successfully completed the required classes
 - d. Completed waiver for both the Iowa and National criminal history record check
 - e. Completed fingerprint card
 - f. Check or money order for application fee (\$85) and background check (\$75) made payable to the Iowa Board of Education Examiners
 - g. Provide proof of current CPR certification

Classes are offered for credit or noncredit online or DMACC Ankeny Campus.

Coaching Authorization or Endorsement — Credit Option

Required Classes:

- ▶ Coaching Ethics, Techniques and Theory (PEC110) - 1 Credit
- ▶ Athletic Development and Human Growth (PEC115) - 1 Credit
- ▶ Intro to Anatomy & Physiology for Coaching (PEC112) - 1 Credit
- ▶ Intro to Athletic Training (PET110) - 2 Credits

Coaching Authorization — Continuing Education

The course is designed for those individuals interested in coaching but do not need a teacher certification or credits. You can take any of the above classes for noncredit also. Classes are posted for noncredit on the continued education website.

Also, a 55-hour program designed to provide instruction as stated in the Code of Iowa. Topics include theory, ethics, athletic training, human development and physiology. First Aid and CPR competencies are included. The certification is optional.

Once coursework is completed, individuals will apply for the Coaching Authorization Certification through the Iowa Board of Educational Examiners. The Coaching Authorization Certificate is valid for five years from date of issue.
