

# READY TO MAKE A *Difference?*



**The Emergency Services Program provides students with the fundamental knowledge and skills needed to provide lifesaving services.**

Students will function in uncommon and high-stress situations by learning to:

- » Perform comprehensive patient assessments
  - › Obtain vital signs
  - › Control hemorrhaging
  - › Bandage wounds
  - › Administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (*including the use of automated external defibrillators*)
- » Provide pre-hospital emergency medical care of simple and multiple system injuries
- » Students completing the course are eligible to test for the EMT certificate and earn 6 DMACC credits.
  - \*\*Students must be at least 17 years of age by the first day of class.*
- » In addition to classroom time, students will be required to attend clinical and field rotations during the course of the class, which will require time outside the classroom.

*\*\* Students will also have to complete a criminal background check.*
