Certificates

Individuals with/ without education or experience can complete a certificate at the same time as the Criminal Justice AAS or AA degree. Certificate courses count in the Option 1 category in the Criminal Justice AAS, or the Electives category in the Criminal Justice AA.

- **Crime Scene Investigation**

Courses focus on forensic documentation, evidence collection and analysis, and procedural reporting and courtroom testimony - 17 credits.

- **Homeland Security**

Courses focus on threats to our nation as it applies to fabricated and natural events - 9 credits.

Students obtaining the Criminal Justice **AAS** degree can complete **BOTH** certificates by strategically selecting the required certificate courses for the 27 Option credits required for the AAS degree.
