Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25 in courses noted below (items 7 – 8). Five Year Rule: Science courses must have been completed no more than 5 years prior to placement on the wait list. The Five Year Rule may be waived if ATI TEAS Science score is 50% or greater. Courses may be in progress when application is submitted.
