How to apply for and use Chapter 33 Post 9/11 GI Bill benefits at DMACC

- 1. Apply for GI Bill benefits
 - a. www.gibill.va.gov
 - b. Apply for Benefits
 - c. Launch Veterans Online Application (VONAPP)
 - d. Complete and submit application (VA Form 22-1990)(Relinquish a GI Bill)
- 2. Receive Certificate of Eligibility from VA Provide to Veterans Services Coordinator
- 3. Apply/Accepted to DMACC
- 4. Register for courses inform Veterans Services Coordinator

How Chapter 33 Post 9/11 GI Bill benefits work

Three types of payment all based on percentage of eligibility Tuition =\$

- 1. Tuition paid to school
 - a. If you are eligible for 100% of benefit, 100% of tuition is paid VA =\$
 - b. If you are eligible for 60% of benefit, 60% of tuition is paid
- 2. Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) paid to you (must be over ½ time)
 - a. based on E-5, with dependants, in Ankeny (zip code of school)
 - b. 100% benefit = \$1.359.00/month

x 4 months =\$

- c. 60% benefit = \$815.40/month
- 3. Book Stipend paid to you (must be over ½ time)
 - a. Paid in two equal installments per school year
 - b. 100% of benefit = \$1,000 (\$500 per term x 2 terms per school year)
 - c. 60% of benefit = $$600 ($300 per term \times 2 terms per school year)$
